SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. Speaker, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 392.

Prior to getting into the amendments on 392, let me announce that while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I propose to sign and do sign engrossed legislative bills, LB 671, LB 772, LB 774, LB 118, LB 120, LB 193, LB 199, LB 291, LB 356, LB 397, and LB 609. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items for the record?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Consideration of amendments on LB 392.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Avery would move to amend with AM1984 found on page 2000 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Avery, on your amendment.

SENATOR AVERY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I believe I'm going to pass over that one and I turned in 1985.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1984 (sic) is withdrawn or passed over?

SENATOR AVERY: I'd like to substitute.
