CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2240-41 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 395 passes with the emergency clause attached. We now turn to Select File and LB 392, and before we get there, items for the record.

CLERK: Madam President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined engrossed LB 646A, and find the same correctly engrossed. Senator Beutler has amendments to LB 526; Senator Bromm amendments to LB 490, those to be printed. I have an explanation of vote from Senator Brown. (Re: LB 699) Study resolution, LR 161-163 by Senator Chambers, LR 164-172 by Senator Wickersham, LR 173 and LR 174 by Senator Lindsay. Those will all be referred to the Executive Board. (See pages 2241-49 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 392.

CLERK: I might indicate to the membership Judiciary is having executive session underneath the south balcony now, Judiciary, south balcony now. 392, Madam President, has been discussed on Select File on May 10, May 11, May 16. Several amendments have been offered, some of which have been adopted. The first amendment I have this morning is by Senator Bernard-Stevens. Senator, AM2089. Would you like to pull that?

PRESIDENT ROBAK: It is so ordered.

CLERK: The next amendment I have, Madam President, is by Senator Avery. Senator, AM1985 in front of me. (Amendment appears on page 2249 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Avery to open on his amendment.

SENATOR AVERY: Thank you, Madam President. This amendment is very similar to what I had ran...brought up before the body anyway several... a week ago I believe. Looking at the figures that we have in terms of reductions, the two areas that I was looking at and with the increases was the state college General Funds and the university General Funds.
