SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 729 passes. LB 732.

CLERK: (Read LB 732 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 732 pass? Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2362-63 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 17 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 732 passes. LB 762.

CLERK: (Read LB 762 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 762 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2363 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 2 nays, 16 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 762 passes. LB 264.

CLERK: (Read LB 264 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All, Mr. Clerk, excuse me, all provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 264 pass? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2364 of the Legislative Journal.) 32 ayes, 1 nay, 3 present and not voting, 13 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 264 passes. We, again because of the light numbers, we are going to roll over 535E and 265E. We will go to LB 626E, however, 626E will be taken up.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Beutler would move to return the bill for a specific amendment. (See AM1975 on page 2241 of the Legislative Journal.)
