LB 325, 325A, 742A, 742

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill, LB 325A by Senator Warner. (Read title.) I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Warner, you are recognized to open on the bill.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is the A bill obviously with LB 325, which transfers a portion of the cost for accounting away from total General Fund to the combination of general, cash, and federal funding. The net effect, as you may recall from the other day, is about a million, over the biennium about a million, four hundred thousand reduction in General Fund ..well, it is about 10,000 less than that. Well, actually, it is a \$1,387,926 less General Fund appropriation. I move the bill be advanced.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Is there any other discussion on the advancement to E & R Initial of LB 325A? Seeing none, Senator Warner waives closing. The question is the advancement to E & R. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 325A.

SENATOR HALL: LB 325A is advanced. LB 742A, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 742A by Senator McKenzie. (Read title.)

SENATOR HALL: Senator McKenzie, you are recognized to open on the bill.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Thank you, Mr. President and members. Just very briefly, this is, of course, the A bill that follows LB 742 as was advanced from General File. If you will look, you will note that the amounts appropriated to the Department of Education have been amended to represent the flat zero percent lid within 5 percent growth in the next budget cycle, which is not included in the A bill, but that was how we advanced LB 742 from General File. With that, I would ask advancement of 742A.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator McKenzie. Mr. Clerk, amendments on the desk.
