

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Request a call of the house and accept call-in votes.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: There has been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The house is under call. Will senators please return to their seats. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. We are accepting call-in votes. The question before the body is the adoption of the Brashear amendment to LB 392. Senators, please check in. We are accepting call-in votes. Senator Warner, will you check in. Senator Bohlke, will you check in. Senator Withem, Senator Hudkins, Senator Schimek, Senator Pirsch, Senator Schellpeper. We are accepting call-in votes.
