

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 392 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 392 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2500 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 34 ayes, 9 nays, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 392 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 394.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 394 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 394 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2501 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting.
