CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR WILL: Senator Maurstad. Senator Maurstad, would you like to make a motion?

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Excuse me, I was reading about a mugging. I would move to advance LB 519 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR WILL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor of advancement of LB 519 say aye. Opposed no. The bill advances. We'll now move to Item 11 on the agenda, legislative resolutions, to be addressed collectively. The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first resolution, LR 257, offered by Senator Hall, is found on page 2385 of the Journal.

SENATOR WILL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President, and members, the resolution merely recognizes the week of June 5th as Management Week in Nebraska. It recognizes the National Management Association and speaks to the employees within the State of Nebraska who are members and a couple of different chartered organizations throughout the state. I would urge adoption. It was brought to me by one of the members who happens to be a manager here within the Legislative Council, and I would urge adoption of the resolution. Thank you.
