

CLERK: May I read some items, Mr. President?

SPEAKER WITHEM: You may.

CLERK: Committee gubernatorial confirmation report by Health Committee, signed by Senator Wesely. Attorney General's Opinion to Senator McKenzie (re. LB 377); and LB 860A is reported to Select File. (See pages 2607-10 of the Legislative Journal.)

Next amendment, Mr. President, is by Senator Schrock. Senator, your amendment is on page 2436 of the Journal.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Before recognizing Senator Schrock, I would announce that LB 860A, the bill that has just been advanced from E & R back to the floor, we just advanced it this morning up to E & R. It will be placed on the agenda at the...right before...right before we recess at lunch time for purposes of hopefully advancing it onto Final Reading. It's LB 860A. Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this is a procedural amendment which puts this present bill back with the language we presently have as it concerns controlled shooting areas. It strikes two shall's and inserts may instead. In other words, if you have two violations the Game and Parks at the present time, under this bill, would be compelled to revoke your license. That means if you fill out somebody's hunting license for them and don't cross a T or dot an I you would become in violation. And it's important to us that this language be inserted here and it would put the bill back, if the bill passes, it would be in compliance the same as the present law that regulates controlled shooting areas. So it's a pretty simple amendment. Any questions, I'd be glad to answer them.
