CLERK: Mr. President, LB 283 on Select File. Senator, I have E & R amendments, first of all.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 283.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The ayes do have it. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend. Senator, may I assume the five components constitute five separate amendments, is that right? (See FA325 on page 2616 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, and I did that to try to save paper.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Senator Chambers, you are recognized.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Members of the Legislature, to make it clear, you are going to get one sheet of paper that contains all of the amendments that I am offering to this bill. But I'm going to take each of them separately, and I put them all on this single sheet in order that I would not have to have copied for each of the 49 senators five separate amendments. Some of them are of less consequence than others, but I will make clear what each is about. The first one is the easiest one. On page 2 of the Enrollment and Review amendments, which now represents the bill, you would find the words, page 2, line 4, "except man". I want to strike those words "except man". This section of statute, 28-1008, relates only to animals, the treatment or mistreatment of animals, and I'd indicated the other day that whenever I see human being or man included in the catalog of animals, and that
