LB 626, 712, 712A

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2685 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 11 nays, 3 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 712 passes. LB 712A.

CLERK: Senator Chambers, I have your motion, Senator, to 712A.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: (Read LB 712A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 712A pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2685-86 of the Legislative Journal.) 35 ayes, 6 nays, 4 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 712A passes. We return now to LB 626.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Beutler, you had the first motion, Senator, the one you had pending when we left the issue.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President, I would withdraw that, and all additional amendments I've filed.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: They are withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Landis, before...oh, Senator Landis would move to return the bill for a specific amendment. Senator, I have the new amendment, AM2596, in front of me. (See page 2686 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Landis to open on the amendment, on the motion, excuse me.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Madam President, members of the Legislature. Senator Kristensen, Senator Beutler and I did our best to reach a common agreement, and there are three purposes that are achieved by this language. It narrows the differences,
