SPEAKER WITHEM: The Hall motions are withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next motion.

CLERK: Senator Bernard-Stevens moved to override, Mr. President. Senator, this is Section 146, Agency 46.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I withdraw that and any other motions I have filed.

SPEAKER WITHEM: It and they are withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Lynch would move to override, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. Speaker, I withdraw that motion and everybody else's that may have amendments.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Nice try. It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on 392, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: We will...there is nothing further filed on LB 392. We will move then to LB 389.

CLERK: Mr. President, 389, with respect to the bill, Senator Wehrbein, as Chair of the Appropriations Committee would move that certain sections, as line-item vetoed by the Governor, become law notwithstanding his objections, and, again, I believe copies have been distributed to the membership, Mr. President. SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, we have, Mr. Speaker, members of the body, if you look at the bottom of your page on the single motion to override on 389, there has been some questions as to why we included some smaller figures, if you will, in there as part of the bill. That is part of the line-item that we have to do. It is an all or none situation. That is the reason that we have Program 07, the Governor, Board of Pardons, Board of Educational Land and Funds, NETV, turn over to the back, Educational TV, or I said that, Public Radio, Coord...all of
