

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2771 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 5 nays on the motion to suspend the rules, Mr. President.

SENATOR HALL: The motion is successful. We're now on Final Reading. All members please return to their seats. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Mr. Clerk, would you move to Item 8 on the agenda.

CLERK: (Read LB 189 on Final Reading )

SENATOR HALL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 189e pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR HALL: The bill passes with the emergency clause. LB 189AE, Mr. Clerk.
