ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 144A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 144A pass? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2784 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 2 nays, 2 present and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 144A passes. LB 613.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 613 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 613 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2784-85 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 36 ayes, 11 nays, 2 present and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 613 passes with the emergency clause attached. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LB 613, LB 144, LB 144A, LB 840, LB 840A, LB 371, LB 742, LB 742A, and certificates of veto overrides on LB 392 and LB 389. (See pages 2785-87 of the Legislative Journal.) We now turn to Item 10 on the agenda and confirmation reports.
