

definitely go to cloture on that one. Senator Will has (LB) 414 coming up. So, if you all don't want to deal with this bill at this point, you can run it on over to Select File. But if you run it over there, it's going to take us a long time to get to it again, because we've got bills on General File that are going to take forever. There are other bills in front of this one on Select File that are going to take a long time, and it's going to take another eight hours on Select File to deal with this one. So, since we are going to deal in this manner this session, I think what I have an obligation to do, based on trying to be direct, as I always purport to behave, to just lay out what I intend to do. This is a session that's not going to achieve anything anyway. It is here for 60 days, this is the third one gone. You're talking about doing something on property taxes. Senator Will and other people who dealt with these tax issues, which I rarely discuss on the floor because there are people on both sides talking about them, if I get involved they know good and well that with my analytical mind there are flaws I will find in every one of these proposals on taxes that is being brought before us. And I will show you, Senator Will, you and your colleagues,...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...that I took taxes in law school, too, that I do understand taxes. I understand what they are. I understand their purpose, and I understand the interests that have their area carved out to be protected by way of the taxing laws. I saw where Union Pacific is going to come here and make the Legislature give them some new concessions, which I intend to fight tooth and nail. So you can kill me, in a manner of speaking, on LB 886. But just like when you put the wrong combination of things in your stomach, that combination takes its revenge, I will not use the term revenge, but I will give as good as I receive. And if the heartlessness and the lack of concern that I see being shown on 886 persists, then I'm going to say that you have set the agenda, you have laid out the rules, you have drawn the line in the sand, you have knocked the little piece of wood off my shoulder, which when you were a child...
