I, again, think that a lot of effort went into this and I appreciate that...that effort to try and draw these different concerns together. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Any further discussion on the motion to advance LB 847? Seeing none, Senator Wickersham, would you mind repeating your explanation of all of the provisions in the bill, or would you prefer to waive closing?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Well, Mr. President, we would probably have to suspend the rules and, rather than ask for that fight, I'll just waive closing.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Question before the body now then is the advancement of LB 847 to E & R Initial. All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Question the body is voting on is, shall LB 847 be advanced to E & R Initial? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 847.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 847 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Appropriations Committee will meet in Room 1003 upon adjournment; Appropriations, 1003 upon adjournment. Senator Maurstad has selected LB 952 as his priority bill for this session. New bills. (Read LB 1159-1161 by title for the first time. See pages 359-60 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they've carefully examined and reviewed LB 886 and recommend the same be placed on Select File.
