Enrollment and Review reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 414 and recommend that same be placed on Select File, 414A, all on Select File. New bills. (Read LB 1226-1236 by title for the first time. See pages 424-30 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, in addition to those items, your Committee on Appropriations, Chaired by Senator Wehrbein, to whom was referred LB 62, instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be indefinitely postponed; LB 211, LB 628, LB 650, LB 720, LB 870, and LR 25, all reported indefinitely postponed. Banking Committee reports LB 532 to General File with committee amendments attached. Those reports signed by the respective chairs. New A bill. (Read LB 29A by title for the first time.) Another priority bill designation: Senator Bromm has selected LB 1226 as his priority bill for this session. Senator Lynch and Senator Maurstad, amendments to be printed to LR 297. And a series of adds: Senator Brown to LB 1226; McKenzie to LB 1226; Fisher to LB 1003; Hudkins, LB 1206; Bohlke, LB 1205; Brown to LB 1206. I believe that's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 427-31 of the Legislative Journal.)
