SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: (Recorder not activated) ...to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber as we begin our eleventh day of this Legislature. Very pleased to have with us from St. Andrews Lutheran Church here in Lincoln two chaplains for the day. We have Pastor Lon Kvanli and Paster Heidi Kvanli.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much. Members, please report to the Chamber and check in.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Quorum is present, the Legislature is in session. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Messages, reports, and announcements?

CLERK: Reference report, Mr. President, referring LB 1237 through 1284 and signed by Senator Coordsen as Chair of Reference. Priority bill designations, Senator Janssen has selected LB 634, Senator Withem has selected LR 276 as their individual priority bills this session. The report of registered lobbyists, required by statute to be filed, will be inserted in the Journal.

Mr. President, I have received a series of reports from the State Auditor. Those will be on file in the Clerk's Office. That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. First item on today's agenda is LB 548. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 548, a bill on General File. A bill originally introduced by Senator Beutler and Lindsay. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 18, referred to the Revenue Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. Committee amendments were considered and adopted on March 23 of
