

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Members, please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. Unauthorized parties, leave the floor. Members in the Chamber, please record your presence. Senator Cudaback, could you check in, please. Senator Beutler, thank you. Senator Wesely, please. Senator Robinson, could you check in, please. We are waiting for Senator Wesely. Senator Chambers has authcrized us to proceed with a machine vote. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment to Senator Lindsay's amendment.
