Amendments to be printed: Senator Fisher, 1175; Senator Will, LR 43; Senator Schellpeper, LR 43CA; Senator Wickersham, 847; and Senator Hillman, 642. And I have a confirmation report from the Education Committee signed by Senator Bohlke as Chair. (See pages 580-84 of the Legislative Journal.)
