SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We've had a request to pass over LB 1050. Next item, LB 349, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 349, a bill introduced originally by Senator Robak, Dierks, and Jones. (Read title.) The bill was introduced in January of last year. At that time, it was referred to the Education Committee, advanced to General File. The committee amendments were discussed on January 30 of this year, Mr. President. There was a motion to bracket the bill that prevailed until February 7. At this time, I have pending the committee amendments. Senator Withem, I had an amendment to the committee amendments. I have a note, Senator, that you would like to withdraw that amendment to the committee amendments.
