CLERK: LB 1123 introduced by the Agriculture Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 8, it was referred to the Agriculture Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Dierks to open on the committee amendments.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Madam President, members of the Legislature. The committee amendment is just very simple, it reinstates language that was stricken. And the reason that the language is stricken when we drafted the bill, well we drafted it a little bit broader than we actually ended up with, included a few other entities. And when we read, got the bill down to where we wanted and forgot to take out some of that language, so it's just as simple as that. I wish you'd accept those committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Dierks. Is there any discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Dierks to close. The closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 1123. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.
