up Section 1 first? Senator Bohlke, have you agreed to the division? Do you agree?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bohlke, would you like to take up the first section of the division?

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Bohlke, you are recognized.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes. All right. Last year, as you may recall, we had this discussion about incentives for school districts, and I'm going to let Senator Wickersham discuss his portion that was, that we have two ideas combined into one bill. And so mine was an incentive for school districts wishing to consolidate. And it actually was a cash incentive. It says that if you move from one tier to another tier and become to a more cost-effective tier, the amount of savings per student from the one tier down to the next times the number of students that you
