CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Your Committee on Revenue, chaired by Senator Warner, reports LB 1320, General File with amendments; LB 267, indefinitely postponed; likewise with LB 272, LB 364, LB 630, LB 945, and LB 1370; and LR 42CA, indefinitely postponed. Natural Resources Committee, LB 1293 to General File; LB 1352, General File; LB 1241, General File with amendments; LB 1385, General File with amendments; LB 1224, indefinitely postponed. New A bill. (Read LB 927A by title for the first time.) Senator Pedersen has amendments to LB 575; Senator Wehrbein and others to LB 1044; Senator Dierks to LB 1174; Senators Wesely and Withem to LB 1044; Senator Schrock, LB 604; Senator Kristensen, LB 1038. And I have a confirmation hearing report from the Retirement Systems Committee. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 928-36 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll now turn to the item on the agenda dealing with Final Reading. Members are to be in their seats. We are now on Final Reading. Members, please take your seats. (Gavel.) Unauthorized parties are to be off the floor. Members, please take your seats, we're on Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, proceed.
