CLERK: LB 973, the last bill, Senator, I have E & R amendments.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 973.

SENATOR COORDSEN: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 973. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 973 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: You've heard the motion to advance LB 973 to E & R for engrossment. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. That ends final...that ends consent calendar for this morning and we move then to General File. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 604 introduced by Senator Schrock and several other members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 18 of last year. At that time it was referred to the Education Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Education Committee amendments pending. SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Bohlke, on the Education Committee amendments.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Mr. President and members, as Senator Schrock will open on the bill and discuss that he's talking about land, and land that should be contiguous to school districts, a certain percentage, 20 percent, his bill really deals with school districts that have reorganized. The committee amendment simply also applies to affiliated.
