That will be laid over. I have a communication from the Chairman of the Executive Board regarding referral...reference of a university bond request. I have a second communication from the Executive Board regarding the designation of the Speaker's five major proposals (re. LB 108, LB 299, LB 1114, LB 1368, and LB 1375). And the last item, Madam President, is a request to have Senator Pirsch have her name removed from LB 1044 as cointroducer. That's all that I have, Madam President.
