LB 962, 1189

Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The bill is returned. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have pending, Mr. President, AM3814.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Stuhr, on your amendment.

SENATOR STUHR: Mr. Speaker and members, I believe I explained the amendment previously and would ask for your support. Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: There are no lights on. Do you have a closing? The question is, shall the Stuhr amendment be adopted? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Mr. President, I'd move to advance LB 962E to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. This concludes our deliberation under Final Reading today. Mr. Clerk, you please bring us up-to-date on LB 1189.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1189, a bill originally introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) Senator Wehrbein, yesterday, presented the Appropriations Committee amendments to the bill. There was an amendment offered by the Appropriations Committee to the committee amendments that was ultimately adopted. The next amendment I have, Mr. President, is by, well, Senator Wehrbein had offered AM3734. He had made a request to withdraw and asked unanimous consent to substitute an amendment. There was an objection.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Neither of the parties involved in that amendment are here. Mr. Clerk, what's the next item?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lindsay would move to amend the committee amendments.
