SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Very pleased today as we begin the forty-fifth legislative day of the 94th Legislature, Second Session that we have from the Methodist Church in York Pastor Paul Blanchard.

Mr. President, a new A bill. Senator Lindsay offered 233A. It's a bill for an act to appropriate funds to implement the provisions of LB 233. And I have, finally, received a report regarding interim reports on dissolution of interim study resolutions. That will be inserted in the Journal. Those
