CLERK: 33 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to invoke cloture.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Cloture is invoked. Our rules now call us for...to go for an immediate vote without any further debate or intervening business to a vote on the pending Dierks amendment. That amendment found on page 1297. All in favor of adopting the Dierks amendment vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to vote? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 8 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on the Dierks amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Dierks amendment is not adopted. Mr. Clerk, we will now vote on the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 108. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Committee amendments are adopted. The matter before the body now is, shall LB 108 be advanced to E & R Initial? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 108.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 108 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, any items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. I have amendments to 1189 by Senator Brown and others; Senator Bernard-Stevens to 1189, and Senator Bernard-Stevens to 1189. Study resolutions, Mr. President, 390...I'm sorry. (Read brief summaries of LR 390-394 for first time.) All will be referred to the Executive Board.
