SENATOR COORDSEN: The Bromm amendment is adopted. Senator Bromm, to readvance the bill, please.

SENATOR BROMM: Yes, Mr. President, I would move that the body be...that the bill be readvanced to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR COORDSEN: There has been a request for a board vote. Those who are in...all those who are in favor of readvancing the bill to Final Reading please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to readvance LB 1205.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The bill is readvanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, Enrollment and Review reports Legislative Bill 700 as correctly engrossed, 700A, 964, 1050, and LB 1050A. Those items reported correctly engrossed. Committee on Urban Affairs, chaired by Senator Hartnett, reports LB 436 to General File with amendments, and LB 608 as indefinitely postponed, was signed by Senator Hartnett. New A bills: 1076A by Senator Wickersham. (Read by title for the first time.) LB 1055A. (Read title.) Senator Beutler would move to print amendments to LB 1053. I have a hearing notice, Mr. President, from the Transportation Committee. Senator Pirsch would like to withdraw her name as cointroducer to LB 1350. And, Mr. President, a unanimous consent request to expedite bills 1368, 299, 1114, 1375, and 108. It's offered by the Speaker. (See pages 1637-46 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: If there are no objections, it is so ordered on the expediting of the bills. There are no objections. The Speaker has indicated to me that we'll be passing over the final three bills, the last three bills on Final Reading. We're now moving to Special Order General File 1996 Senator Priority Bills. The Speaker has indicated that these bills will have a 30 minute time limit each. Mr. Clerk, first bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, 952, a bill originally introduced by Senator Maurstad, has been discussed. The latest action was to bracket the bill. When the Legislature left the issue on March 4, I had pending to the bill an amendment by Senator
