LB 1190A, 1190

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CROSBY: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to advance LB 1190 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 1190 to E & R for engrossment. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. LB 1190A, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 1190A, Senator, I have Enrollment and Review amendments first of all.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Maurstad.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Madam President, I'd move to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 1190A.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to 1190A. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Lynch would move to amend with AM4227. (See page 1730 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Madam Chairman and members, what this simply does is since amendments were developed in the main bill this strikes '97 and '98 from LB 1190A, as you all know, we already amended to take it a year at a time and this amendment is needed as it applies to the funding process and the Appropriations Committee considerations to make sure we're doing it in both the A bill and the main bill the same way. I'd ask for your support.

SENATOR CROSBY: Discussion on the Lynch amendment? Seeing there are no lights, Senator Lynch, he waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Lynch amendment to 1190A. All
