workload and everything else that they see right now, January 17 would be a last day for receipt of bill drafts by bill drafting. Typically, what that means is, any bill you get to them by the time of January 17, you'd be guaranteed that they would get it back to you in time for being introduced on the 22nd. Obviously, bill drafts can be taken up after that, but the guarantee date would not...would not be there. Those, basically, are the types of questions we usually get this time of year trying to proactively answer some of those questions. Michelle will be getting a memo out to your offices containing that information. Any other questions about procedures and scheduling for the first few days of the session, I'd be happy to address those. Mr. Clerk, any other items?

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read by title for the first time LB 89-101. See pages 121-23 in the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: (Microphone not on)...from Senator Warner's District, we have Dr. Dale Michaels. Dr. Michaels would you say hello to us, please? Thank you very much for being here. Mr. Clerk, you have some items?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do. New resolutions. (Read brief summary of LR 5-30. See pages 123-45 in the Legislative Journal.) Those will all be referred to the Reference Committee because they're constitutional amendments, Mr. President. New bills. (Read by title for the first time LB 102-114. See pages 145-47 in the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: (Microphone turned off)...have a motion that we need to deal with regarding the inauguration. Can we take care of that? The Chair would recognize Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Speaker, I move that a series of committees be appointed to escort the various state and constitutional officers for the purpose of administering their oaths of office.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've hear the motion. Any discussion? Seeing none. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. Motion is carried. Mr. Clerk, do you have any other items?
