SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to the amendment to the rules. There's a request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye. Opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 1 nay to place the house under call, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please return to the Chamber and take your seats. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Abboud, Senator Bohlke, the house is under call. Senator Brashear. Senator Schellpeper. Senator Preister. Senator Hartnett, Senator Hilgert, Senator Jones, the house is under call. Senator Cudaback and Senator Bromm. Senator Cudaback and Senator Bromm, the house is under call. Senator Cudaback, Senator Bromm, Senator Jones, the house is under call. Senator Bohlke, Senator Hilgert. Senator Jones, would you like to check in. Senator Bohlke and Senator Cudaback, the house is under call. All present and accounted for. A roll call vote has been requested. We are voting on Senator Chambers' amendment to amendment number 5 to the permanent rules. All in favor vote aye and opposed no. Mr. Clerk, would you please call the roll?

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 222 in the Legislative Journal.) 17 ayes, 23 nays on the motion, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment fails. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record? Bills? I will raise the call.

CLERK: I do, Madam President. Thank you. New bills. (Read LB 283-317 by title. See pages 223-29.) That's all that I have at this time, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Madam President, I would ask that we, for the time being, pass over this proposed amendment and move to
