SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the motion to adopt temporary rules...or permanent rules, excuse me.

SENATOR CROSBY: We are on the motion to adopt permanent rules. Senator Withem.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Yeah. I would simply move that the permanent rules be adopted.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. You've heard the motion to adopt permanent rules. Is there any further discussion? Seeing none. Senator Withem, did you have any closing? No closing. The question is the adoption of the permanent rules. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to adopt the permanent rules.
