PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Our pastor for the day is Pastor Homer Clements, of Bennet Community Church. Pastor Clements.

PASTOR CLEMENTS: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Pastor Clements. I now call the tenth day of the Legislature to order. Will senators please record your presence. Please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: Madam President, on page 353, line 32, strike "January 21" and insert "January 22". That's the only item I have.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any messages, reports, and announcements?

CLERK: Reference Report referring LBs 439 through LB 500, and LRs 50 and 52CA. Hearing notice from the Revenue Committee signed by its Chair, Senator Warner. LR 49 and 51 are ready for your signature. I have a report from the Lower Niobrara Natural Resources District regarding payment of attorney fees. That will be on file in the Clerk's Office; and a report from the Department of Roads, required by statute. That, as well, will be on file in the Clerk's Office.
