It would also identify all locations within the district where the actual test could be picked up. That, I think, would serve the purpose of notifying the public of proposed changes, and it would also be more practical because the location where people could pick up the text that were interested in it would be conveniently located in city halls, of course an NRD office, in various places throughout the district. And some of these districts, as you know, cover many counties, so we'd want to have the text available, of course, in each courthouse and various places throughout the district. But at a time when we're trying to impress upon local subdivisions, including NRDs, the essence of saving money and trying to reduce our budgets, it would be much more advisable to require a notice that informs the public, serves the purpose, and yet we could do a notice for just, maybe, two or three hundred dollars instead of three or four thousand dollars. So, we did have a good public hearing. We had no opposition. Even the Press Association, who did not really testify at that hearing, they came forward in a subsequent hearing in the committee later that afternoon and indicated that they thought the change made sense. They had no opposition. So, we're very confident that this is a positive change. I would ask the body to advance the bill. Be glad to answer any questions. I'm gradually getting my breath back and will get stronger as the day goes along, Mr. Speaker. So, thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thanks, Senator Bromm. I'm not sure anybody would be cruel enough to make you stand and answer questions until you do catch your breath. There are no further lights on. Did you care to close?
