SPEAKER WITHEM: Thanks, Senator Wickersham. There are no other lights on. Would you care to close? Closing is waived. The question is, shall LB 46 be advanced? All in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay.

SENATOR COORDSEN PRESIDING

SENATOR COORDSEN: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 46.

SENATOR COORDSEN: LB 46 is advanced. New items, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Government, Military, and Veterans Affairs reports LB 71 to General File, (LB) 131 to General File. Those reports signed by Senator Robinson as Chair. Amendments to be printed. Senator Cudaback to LB 71. Senator Robinson to LB 40. (See page 437 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Mr. Clerk, LR 5CA.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 5CA, introduced by Senator Stuhr and other members. It's a resolution proposing an amendment to Article III, Section 10 of the Nebraska Constitution. The resolution was introduced on January 9 of this year. At that time was referred to the Government, Military, and Veterans Affairs Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Stuhr. to introduce the resolution.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. LR 5CA is a proposal to shorten the 90-day session to 80 days and to convene sessions for not more than five days in early December. And I want to stress that it does state not more than five days. I do have an amendment that just changed.
