But nevertheless, as Senator Landis pointed out, I have no formal position of leadership in this Legislature. I manage to get things done. Some things done through this legislature that are not done in the largest legislatures in the country. Some things that set a tone, not only for other legislatures in this country, but for Congress in terms of legislation, such as the bill that required the restoration of the remains of Native Americans to their family or tribe members. But nevertheless, Senator Withem's amendment mitigates the damage that is being done here. Even though I find a way under the rules to do what it is that I need to do, you don't find me tinkering and fiddling and saying, if we change the system, somehow that's going to make me more effective. If you're not effective, the system is not going to correct that for you. You have to do it. The Chair mentioned that there is some free food in the lounge. First expression that jumped in my mind when I heard that was the phrase or the term "lounge lizard", and some people think that's of recent vintage, but actually, that was a term created by Sinclair Lewis in Babbitt some time ago. Somebody came across that, liked it, and used it, and now people think it's a modern term, similar to "couch potato". I don't know where that came from. But nevertheless, if you meet in December and talk about all these bills you're going to have for introduction, it means that new senators are going to have to become familiar enough with the issues to get their requests for bills in earlier. In fact, everybody's going to have to get their requests in earlier so that you'll have all these bills just waiting to tumble into the hopper December 1 or December 5. I wouldn't attend those days. It would be a waste of time in my opinion. So, when you organize and you're going to elect people, you better not break down to a 24-24 number, because you'll be there stuck forever. As for talking about a cooling off period, should you have a heated contest, what you will do is give people a chance to go home and brood and brood and be ready when they come back to do their delaying and getting even then. If you require the session to start immediately after these acrimonious contests, should they occur, people don't have time to engage in those retaliatory activities because they'll be left in the dust. But nevertheless, if somebody is angry enough, you deliver that three days into their hands. Anybody can exhaust three days.
