Legislature, I believe, because they have a deep caring for good government and they're willing to set aside for a period of time their jobs, their aspirations, have to work out certain considerations with family. So, once again, I'll reiterate, I don't think a compelling reason has been made to shorten the length of the session, and as a result, I think it should remain 90 days, that's what this amendment would do, and would ask the members to adopt amendment 55.
