CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the approval of the appointment to the Liquor Control Commission.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Liquor Control Commission confirmation report is adopted. The third report.

CLERK: State Electrical Board, Senator.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Madam Chairman and members. This reappointment is for the State Electrical Board. It is William Whitmer from Lincoln. He currently has been on the board three terms. This is his fourth term. I move for the appointment to the Electrical Board. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, Senator Schellpeper waives closing. The question before you is the adoption of the General Affairs Committee Electrical Board confirmation report. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.
