SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Before beginning the agenda, I would like to announce that Senator Warner recognizes Dr. Kent Willadsen of Lincoln who is our family doctor of the day. Dr. Willadsen, would you stand so the Legislature may welcome you. Thank you. And also, Senator Bruning has guests this morning under the south balcony: Bob Diekmann, Superintendent of the South Sarpy District 46 Schools; and Gail Copelin, Superintendent of the Gretna Schools. Would you please stand and be welcomed by your Legislature. Thank you. We move to General File. LB 10A. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 10A. Introduced by Senator Coordsen. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 29, referred directly to General File, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Senator Coordsen, on 10A.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. You may remember that LB 10 was a bill that assisted the Department of Motor Vehicles in reducing their expenditures. This is the A bill that follows that. It indicates that there will be a reduction in the case expenditures of the Department of Motor Vehicles of the amount of \$33,000 in the next fiscal year, and \$44,000 in the fiscal years 98 to 99. With that, Madam President, I would move the advancement of LB 10A.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Any discussion on LB 10A? Seeing none. Senator Coordsen waives closing. The question is the advancement of LB 10A to E & R Initial. All in favor vote aye. Opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 10A.

SENATOR CROSBY: (LB) 10A advances. LB 113A.
