SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Father Christian Pierce, St. Matthews Episcopal Church, Lincoln. Father.

CLERK: Madam President, LR 72, introduced by Senator Hilgert. It's found on page 521 of the Legislative Journal.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Hilgert.
