proud to say my long time friend, former State Senator Tim Hall, last Saturday morning lost his father. So, therefore, I have introduced LR 72. It says, "Whereas, Bernard Hall, father of former State Senator Tim Hall, died in Tucson, Arizona, on February 1, 1997; and whereas, Bernard Hall was a South High graduate, and was born and raised in South Omaha; and whereas, Bernard Hall was a dedicated family man, a father of fifteen children. His children included business leaders, state government leaders, and religious leaders; and whereas, Bernard Hall served his country in World War II in the Army Air Guard; and whereas, Bernard Hall was a Postal Service worker for thirty-five years. Now, therefore, be it resolved by the members of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature of Nebraska, First Session: That the Legislature extends its condolences and sympathy to the family of the late Bernard Hall. And that a copy of this resolution be sent to his widow, Catherine Fischer Hall, and his family."
