SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, and Senator Cudaback, I know exactly what you're doing and I agree with it. But I want to ask you a question just for the record. The way the amendment reads is that you can have that these people must own property in the county or a cemetery plot, and go ahead then.

SENATOR CUDABACK: I did erase that language, Senator Chambers, that's gone now.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right. So then read your amendment as you intend to....

SENATOR CUDABACK: It simply goes to three or five board members.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So then the amendment that's printed on our screen is not your amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: No, that's Senator Beutler's, but he withdrew that amendment. Senator Beutler did withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I would like to ask, Senator Cudaback, has a copy of your amendment been printed?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Can I take a second and look at that amendment, then I might not even have to make the comment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It's on page 490, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Let me ask the question, is it on...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Page 490.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Chambers, it should be on the screen in the proposed amendment tab.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I was just told that that was not the one that we're considering, that there's a different one.
