

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Dierks.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...or is there an outright loss of the revenue?

SENATOR DIERKS: I think that your first assumption is right, because you see you have, instead of these fees coming in quarterly, they're going to be collected on an annual basis after the bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Wouldn't...wouldn't...shouldn't the next fiscal year then show an increase? Well, I'll talk to you about it later.

SENATOR DIERKS: I'm not sure.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I just thought...

SENATOR DIERKS: Okay. I don't know that...to tell you the truth, I hadn't even looked at it, so....

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR DIERKS: Yes.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Dierks, to close. Closing is waived. The question before you is the advancement of LB 202. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 202.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 202 advances. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Madam President, hearing notices from the Government...or cancellation of a hearing from the Government Committee. Hearing notice from Natural Resources, signed by the respective chair. Senator Jensen would like to print amendments
