SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber as we begin today, the twenty-third day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. We're pleased to have, from the Capitol City Christian Church here in Lincoln, Pastor Bill Thornton.
