CLERK: (Read LB 61 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 61 pass? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to vote? Mr. Clerk, record.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 600 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 10 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 61 passes. LB 71.

CLERK: (Read LB 71 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 71 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 601 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 38 ayes, 1 nay, 1 present and not voting, 9 excused and not voting.
