SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 188 pass with the emergency clause attached? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 604-05 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 44, the first motion, the first vote we will take on LB 44 will be the question of whether the at large reading of this particular bill should be dispensed with. So that is the question before the body at this point, shall the at large reading of LB 44 be suspended? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the at large reading.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The at large reading will be dispensed with. Mr. Clerk, please read the title of the bill.

CLERK: (Read title of LB 44 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: The title has been read. The question now is, all provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, shall LB 44 pass? All of those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
