PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Merv Goodrick from Fellowship Baptist Church, here in Lincoln. Pastor Goodrick.

PASTOR MERV GOODRICK: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Pastor Goodrick. I now call the twenty-fourth legislative day to order. Will Senators please record their presence.

CLERK: Quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any messages, reports, and announcements?

CLERK: Your Committee on Retirement Systems reports LB 623 to General File with amendments attached. That is signed by Senator Wickersham.
