CLERK: Agriculture Committee has a report found on page 614, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body. The Legislature's Committee on Agriculture wishes to report favorably upon the reappointment of two members to the Nebraska Dry Bean Commission. They are Dick Wagoner and Mary Weyers, both residents of the Panhandle. Neither were able to come in for the confirmation hearing but the report was favorable and we wish to honor that request of the Governor. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Dierks. Any discussion of the Agriculture Committee confirmation report? Seeing none, Senator Dierks, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of the Agriculture Committee confirmation report. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have all the senators voted? Please record.
