SPEAKER WITHEM: Final Reading is dispensed on LB 185.
Mr. Clerk, read the title.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 185 introduced by Senator Wesely.
(Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure
having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 185 pass?
All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record,
Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 735 of the
Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not
voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 185 passes. Next item will be a vote to
dispense with the at large reading of LB 79. All of those in
favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to dispense
with Final Reading.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Mr. Clerk, please read the title.

CLERK: LB 79 by Senator Schimek. (Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure
having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 79 pass?
All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record,
Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 736 of the
Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not
voting, Mr. President.
